Applicants must meet requirements determined by the national programme “[Programm zur Forschung und Entwicklung im BMLRT 2020-2025](#)”, and each proposal submitted must be in line with the general policies of the BML.

- Applying organisations shall contact their respective legal department and research service department, if any, to clarify internal coherence for all applicants from that particular organisation. Applicants must keep their national contact point informed in the course of the pre-proposal phase, so to avoid ineligibility of the proposal.
- Requested BML contribution per project is limited to the budget provided in the table of the indicative call budget. The requested contribution includes the total costs requested (inkl. VAT) – value added tax cannot be requested additionally.
- For one eligible project there will be only one contract between BML and the respective Austrian partner, whereas additional Austrian partners shall be subcontracted. The Austrian partners should decide upon the lead partner amongst themselves at an early stage, and the lead partner must be eligible for funding.

- After the final selection for funding of a proposal the Austrian partner has to submit the project via www.dafne.at.
- Amortisation costs for equipment are eligible in proportion to the share relevant for the project.
- Travel and meeting costs are eligible according to the Austrian "RGV".
- Overhead costs maximum 20% of direct costs.
- Payments by BML principally consist of prepayment, payment after approval of the Interim Report, and a final payment after the approval of the Final Report (min. 10% of the requested BML contribution).
- The institutions with partial legal capacity, which are established at the research-active agencies (Dienststellen) of the BML, are eligible for funding in this specific call, as it is an international and competitive call.

TOPIC 1 - BEWERTUNG UND EVIDENZBASIERTE DARSTELLUNG DER ÖKOLOGISCHEN, WIRTSCHAFTLICHEN UND SOZIALEN LEISTUNGEN DER AGRARÖKOLOGIE:

Landwirtschaftliche Umweltleistungen bzw. die Umsetzung von agrarökologischen Praktiken haben im GAP-Strategieplan 2023-27 eine hohe Priorität, weil dadurch wichtige Beiträge zu EU-weiten Zielsetzungen im (Agrar)Umweltbereich geleistet werden. Zentrale Themen für Forschungsarbeiten sind daher aus Sicht des BMLs insbesondere die Bewertung der Effektivität von agrarökologischen Praktiken auf die Schutzgüter Biodiversität, Boden, Wasser, Luft und Klima. Besonders interessant ist in diesem Zusammenhang die Frage, inwiefern eine agrarökologisch ausgerichtete Landwirtschaft auch positiven Einfluss auf die soziale und wirtschaftliche Dimension der Nachhaltigkeit besitzt. D.h. inwiefern diese Praktiken soziales Wohlbefinden, Arbeitsbedingungen, sowie die wirtschaftliche Lebensfähigkeit von Betrieben oder deren Abhängigkeit vom Markt beeinflussen.

Aus Sicht des BMLs bilden Forschungsvorhaben zur evidenzbasierten Bewertung agrarökologischer Praktiken und der Untersuchung ihrer Effekte auf ökonomische, soziale und ökologische Performance von Betrieben zentrale Voraussetzung für eine bessere Anerkennung agrarökologischen Wirtschaftsweisen durch den Landwirtschaftssektor, den Markt, sowie durch politische Entscheidungsträger:innen.

Ein weiteres wichtiges Thema für das BML ist der Beitrag einer agrarökologisch ausgerichteten Landwirtschaft zur betrieblichen Resilienz – sowohl aus Perspektive des Klimawandels (z.B. Anpassungsmöglichkeit an Extremwetterereignisse/ neue Pflanzenkrankheiten & Schädlinge) als auch aus ökonomischer Hinsicht (z.B. Erschließung neuer Geschäftsmodelle, Diversifizierung).

Es ist entscheidend, in jedem Schritt die spezifischen Bedingungen und die Besonderheiten der einzelnen Standorte zu berücksichtigen und darauf abgestimmte agrarökologische Praktiken zu forcieren und einzubinden.

TOPIC 2: UMGESTALTUNG VON WERTSCHÖPFUNGSKETTEN, UNTERNEHMEN UND POLITIKEN ZUR ERLEICHTERUNG DES ÜBERGANGS ZUR AGRARÖKOLOGIE

Dieses Thema ist für das BML interessant, weil ein langfristiger Erfolg von agrarökologischen Praktiken nur dann gesichert ist, wenn agrarökologisch erzeugte Produkte auch einen entsprechenden Wert am Markt erzielen bzw. wenn sich durch die agrarökologische Wirtschaftsweise ein (neues) Geschäftsmodell für Betriebe erschließt. Öffentliche Förderungen bzw. die Gestaltung von Politiken zur Umsetzung agrarökologischer Praktiken sind zweifelsfrei sehr wichtig zur Initiierung des agrarökologischen Wandels. Damit sich dieser Übergang zur Agrarökologie langfristig etablieren kann, muss sich eine agrarökologisch ausgerichtete Landwirtschaft aber jedenfalls auch ökonomisch rentieren. Zentrale Themen für Forschungsarbeiten sind daher aus Sicht des BMLs die Entwicklung von innovativen



Geschäftsmodellen, sowie die Weiterentwicklung bestehender Labels und Vermarktungskonzepten zur erfolgreichen Verankerung einer agrarökologisch ausgerichteten Landwirtschaft in der Wertschöpfungskette. Dazu auch Untersuchungen, wie eine Transformation bzw. Diversifizierung der Wertschöpfungskette möglich wäre, damit agrarökologische Praktiken stärker berücksichtigt werden könnten.

Forschungsarbeiten, die neue Erkenntnisse zur Ausgestaltung von politischen Unterstützungsinstrumenten für agrarökologische Praktiken bringen, sind aus BML Sicht ebenfalls willkommen.

GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR CALLS

MMM uses so called total cost model where funding for research organizations and universities covers 70 % of the project's gross eligible costs. For companies the maximum funding is 50% (please note the EU's state aid rules). Product development supporting individual companies will not be supported, neither machinery nor equipment, unless they have been specifically approved by ministry. The results of funded projects must be open for access by all potential user groups. Costs that are necessary and reasonable in view of the project work and which can be allocated to the project in accounting are considered acceptable costs. The costs must be incurred during the period of time indicated in the funding decision in order to be approved. Costs incurred before the application was submitted will not be approved as project costs.

The responsible administrator of the research/development project must be duly authorised to act for and on behalf of the recipient(s) of the funding in project-related matters as if such actions were carried out by the recipient(s) themselves.

MMM urges all applicants to get in touch with the national contact person already in the early phase of the project planning.

The maximum amount that can be requested from ANR by each proposal with French applicant(s) is:

- 400.000 € if the Coordinating Partner is requesting funding to ANR and is eligible for funding by ANR
- 300.000 € (for standard French Partners)

The minimum amount per beneficiary is 15 000€.

If there are several French partners requesting funds from ANR, the total requested funding from ANR (300 000 €, extended to 400 000 € if the coordinating partner is requesting funding to ANR) must be split among them.

ELIGIBLE INSTITUTIONS

ANR may fund research organisations and undertakings, as defined by the EC regulation on State aid for research, development and innovation (see the ANR Funding regulations for further

reference). Only research organisations that have their primary establishment in France may be funded. As for undertakings, ANR may fund those that have their real head office in an EU member State and an establishment (primary or secondary) in France.

In this call, to be eligible, the consortium must include at least one French public research organization (EPA, EPSCP, EPST, EPIC).

The involvement of an enterprise is encouraged but not mandatory. **If a non-French enterprise is involved in a project and requests funds from a funding organisation other than a French funding organisation, it is mandatory to involve a French enterprise; otherwise the French partners requesting funding from ANR will be declared ineligible.**

Partners from countries subject to sanctions applicable to the research field by the European Union authorities are excluded from this call for ANR. ANR will declare Partners requesting its support ineligible if they apply with Partners established in these countries. At the date of publication, these exclusions concern Partners from the following countries: Russia, Belarus. This list may evolve in case of new sanctions decided by the European Union.

Personnel costs (gross salary without overheads) for the people involved in the project.

Travel, accommodation and meal costs of people directly involved in the project and exclusively for the purpose of the project.

Contractual research costs, technical knowledge and patents bought or licensed from outside sources at market prices, and costs for consulting and equivalent services intended exclusively for the research activity.

Instrument and equipment costs, to the extent and during the period in which they are used for the research project.

Communication expenses: communication tools (services for creation, publishing costs), communication event (room renting, travel costs of people directly involved in the project).

Indirect costs and other operating expenses (including costs for material, supplies and similar products): 15% of total eligible costs.

Other: The regional grant is expected to have an incentive effect. Thus, the expenses are eligible from the date of full proposal submission.

B) FUNDING RATES

The project activities of Slovenian partners in each consortium have to be under the supervision of the primary investigator/primary researcher who fulfills the requirements for a project leader as defined in the first paragraph of Article 63 of ZZrID.

ELIGIBLE COSTS

MKGP will fund all eligible costs of successful Slovenian transnational projects, recommended for funding, in accordance with the [Decree on the scientific research funding from the budget of the Republic of Slovenia](#) (*Uredba o financiranju znanstvenoraziskovalne dejavnosti iz Proračuna Republike Slovenije*). Eligible costs are defined based on the FTE value according to the research project categorization of ARIS (A, B, C or D, based on the research conducted).

Eligible costs must be directly related to the research conducted and mandatory include all the following categories as elements of the FTE:

- **personnel** (including social security, health, pension, and other contributions according to national legislation);
- **material** (travel and meetings costs, consumables, dissemination and knowledge exchange costs, other costs);
- **depreciation costs.**

- Only personnel costs for new temporary employment dedicated to the project are eligible. This must be clearly stated in the contract. The costs of permanent staff linked to the beneficiary entity or members of the research team will not be considered eligible costs.
- Direct costs such as current costs, small scientific equipment, disposable materials, travelling expenses, coordination costs and other costs that can be justified as necessary to carry out the proposed activities.
- Indirect costs (25% of all direct costs, including the subcontracting costs).

- **Minor changes of the budget** might be accepted between the pre-proposal stage and the full proposal stage, provided that the maximum requested amount does not exceed the maximum funding per project allowed. A request of change must be submitted to the AEI at least two weeks before the deadline for submitting full proposals.
- The AEI will avoid double funding (overlapping with other EU or National funding) and will not grant projects or parts of projects already funded.

Up to an additional maximum of € 30.000 (direct costs) can be granted for the entire proposal if the work plan includes substantial experimental tasks. These type of tasks are related to the adoption of observational or experimental approaches in the research projects, involving for instance, designing and executing new experiments; resulting in new data sets, using appropriate procedures for the quantification of relevant variables and the analysis of the data resulting from those experiments. Tasks that exclusively involve the use or re-analysis of existing data will be considered as deskwork and not substantial experimental tasks”

Important:

- Only ONE applicant applying for funding to AEI is allowed per proposal
- Two AEI-applicants are allowed in the same proposal only in cases when one of them is acting as Coordinator
- **The direct costs (including subcontracting) in the application must be rounded to the thousands.**

Other Funding Criteria

- Centres formed by different Spanish legal entities will be considered as a unique entity, and thus the maximum funding should not exceed the limits per proposal established above (for example, mixed centres).
- Two centres or institutions belonging to the Consejo Superior de Investigaciones Científicas (CSIC) will be treated as two separate partners one from another when one of them is acting as Coordinator of the proposal and their tasks and identity in the project are sufficiently separated and justified.

- Although private enterprises are not funded by the AEI, the Spanish industrial sector is welcome to participate in the transnational consortia principally obtaining funds from the CDTI participating in this transnational call (see CDTI's requirements), from other innovation and technological development funding agencies, or using own funds.
- The final funding will take into account the transnational evaluation of the collaborative proposal, the scientific quality of the Spanish group, the added value of the international collaboration, the participation of the industrial sector, and the financial resources available.
- All themes in this transnational call are eligible for funding.

Junta de Extremadura (JUNTAEX) will finance the activities to be developed by the Extremadura entities identified above as eligible partners for funding in the Autonomous Community of Extremadura.

The regional contribution will be co-funded with the European Regional Development Fund (2021-2027).

Eligible costs will be those directly related and strictly necessary for the implementation of the project activities and taking place within the project period.

The categories of eligible costs in the case of Extremadura entities applying for regional grant will be the following: personnel costs necessary for the execution of the activity, costs of other goods and services directly related to the activities of the project, travel and depreciation of scientific and technological equipment.

Indirect costs will be calculated as a percentage of 7% of the total amount executed.
